The Men's Member-Guest went well.

Greens seem to be responding well from post-tournament.

Night time temperatures have been ideal for growing

The speed of the greens for the tournament was 10 ½ to 11 based on the stimpmeter.

Fairways 3,7 & 10 sat underwater & have thinned out. Will most likely be aerified.

Discussion ensued on the unevenness of the the fairway on hole 6. This is due to the rock beneath it. Not sure if there is a solution to repair this.

Junior golf is on Monday morning conflicts with the maintenance done on that morning. May consider moving either Junior golf or maintenance to Thursday. This could be a conflict with womens pick up league and stag day.

The dumping on the side of 16 is going fine but it is a slow process. There is more to come and eventually a berm will be built to hide the maintenance sheds.

Discussion on thinning out the trees between 14 & 15.

Sprinkler head repairs – some are uneven.

Discussion on moving the women's 8th tee forward to 120 yards out to make the green more attainable on the tee shot. The shot would be over the right bunker. Linda will pulse the women to see what other tee boxes they would like to see moved forward.
